Renaissance Adventures Overnight Camp at Cal-Wood 4:00 pm Tuesday 7/10/07 through 1:00 pm Friday 7/13/07

Arrivals and Departures - Please arrive on the first day of the session at 4:00 pm in the afternoon. Please plan to pick up your children on the last day of the session at 1:00 pm after lunch. See enclosed directions sheet for driving directions to Cal-Wood.

Where To Meet - Meet in the first lot on the right, next to a pond, across from a white house. A R.A. staff member will be located in this lower parking lot for check in. This staff member will collect any last minute forms and payments. Campers will also be told which group they will be in at this time. Do not drive past that lot unless directed to by RA staff. Cal-Wood requests that we limit the vehicle traffic between the parking lot and the cabins. You will be asked to load your camper's gear into a shuttle van which will bring the gear up to the cabins. Parents and campers will walk up to the cabins to gather their gear and bring it to their cabin (exceptions will be made for individuals who are unable to hike up to the cabins). Please plan to spend 45 minutes to one hour getting your camper checked in and settled in.

What Not to Bring- Electronic games or radios, illegal substances, guns, large knives, fireworks, tobacco, and alcohol are forbidden. Please do not bring candy or snacks unless you bring enough to share with your cabin, under the supervision of your counselor. Please do not bring personal food unless you have special dietary needs.

Food - We will be serving healthy meals and snacks, including fare for vegetarians. If your child has special dietary restrictions or needs you may send food with them but please let us know ahead of time so we can understand your child's needs. Personal food will be stored in the kitchen and its use will be supervised by R.A. staff.

Phone Calls - We discourage campers from calling home unless absolutely necessary. Important messages can be left for campers on our office phone (303-786-9216) which is checked daily. It is also possible to leave an emergency message for us at Cal-Wood at (303) 449-0603, or on Cal-Wood's Fax at 303-449-0576.

Friends - If your child has friends they would like in their cabin, and if you did not indicate that on the registration form, then please notify us at least three weeks before camp begins. We will do our best to place friends together.

Sleeping Arrangements - Phoenix campers sleep on bunk beds in cabins that house one adult quest leader and six or seven campers. The bathroom and shower facility is located within 25-50 yards of the cabins. Adult staff sleep in the same cabin as the groups of campers, and additional adult staff sleep in the lodge.

Directions to Cal-Wood

From Denver/Boulder

- Head west on Highway 36 (Boulder-Denver Turnpike). Highway 36 turns into 28th Street through Boulder, so continue heading north.
- From the very north edge of Boulder, where CO Highway 7 (Broadway) and U.S. 36 (28th St.) meet, continue out of town on Highway 36 for about 5 miles to Left Hand Canyon Road, where a sign will point you to "Ward/Jamestown." Turn Left.
- Bear to the right at the first junction with Olde Stage Road (about 2 1/2 miles) and to the right again at the next junction (about 3 miles - follow signs to Jamestown). Continue through the very small town of Jamestown (about 8 1/2 miles from the Left Hand Canyon Road turn-off).
- 1.3 miles past the stop sign in Jamestown take a right leading upward on County. Rd. 87 (Balarat Road). This is a steep mountain road; please drive slowly and safely. Take a left at the fork at the top of the hill. Continue for another 100 yards or so, and take another left at the next fork.
- Continue slowly approximately 2 miles (past the sign that reads "Not a Through Street" and you will see a gate on the right for Cal-Wood. Proceed slowly through the main gate and parking is available 1/2 mile down the road on the right, across from the white house.
- Cross the dirt road and walk on the Lodge Trail to the right (east) of the small cabin (The small cabin and nearby white house are private staff residences. Follow the Lodge trail up over the hill (north) and across a gravel road for a couple hundred yards to the Lodge (total distance from parking lot is ¼ mile.)
