Greetings from Renaissance Adventures! This packet contains all of the registration materials we need to ensure a safe, fun environment for your child. In order to process your registration, please be sure to complete *all* of the forms and send them in with your check or credit card information. We realize that there is a lot of information to fill out, and thank you for spending the time to do so.

We recommend that you send in your registration forms early to ensure a place for your child and to receive the Early Bird Discount. Below is a registration forms checklist, check-in and out information, a list of items to bring to camp, and directions. We are delighted to provide camp for your child and anticipate a magical season!

Registration Forms Checklist

What to Bring to Camp

- Lunch, snack, and filled water bottle (please send two bottles for full-day Dragon camps)
- Hat and pre-applied sunscreen
- Backpack
- Hiking boots or sneakers - please no sandals or Crocs. Optionally you may bring a pair of wading shoes.
- Poncho and sweatshirt
- Please do not bring electronic games, candy, gum, pocket knives, or excess money.

Directions to Renaissance Adventures

302 Pearl Street (the Solstice Institute): Take highway 36 into Boulder where Highway 36 becomes 28th street. From 28th street, take Canyon Blvd. west past Broadway and the Justice Center. Turn right (North) onto Third Street. There is a car wash on the corner of Canyon and Third. The Solstice Institute Studios are located on the southeast corner of Third and Pearl. For classes and camps, enter the building through the Third Street door. For the office, enter the building through the Pearl Street door. Our office is immediately on your left.

Parking: Park only on the east side of Third Street or on Pearl Street. Please *do not* park in the alley and do not block Meyer's Heating & Plumbing business on the west side of Third Street! Thank you.

Site Features: 302 Pearl Street is a beautiful site located on West Pearl Street in Boulder. This site offers two indoor studio rooms for rainy weather. Campers meet at the building and spend the day questing outdoors in nearby public parks including Eben G. Fine Park and Settlers' Park. Large shady trees and the Boulder Creek make Eben G. Fine Park a comfortable place to get out of the afternoon sun. Settlers' Park features hiking trails and a unique natural environment of forests, mountains, and red rock boulders.

Check-in and Check-out Details

Camps begin at 8:30 a.m. and end at 1:30 p.m. or 4:30 p.m. depending on the session your child is enrolled in. Our staff are typically available to sign campers in by 8:25 a.m. We ask for parents to bring their child to their group leader and to sign in and out with the group leader in the morning and afternoon. For older campers, parents can give permission to have the child sign in and out on his own. You will find this permission waiver on the Health Form. If you are unsure whether you have given your child permission to sign himself in or out, please check with the group leader to look on the health form.

During each pick up, staff will stay late and wait with the children whose parents have not arrived. There is a ten minute grace period for picking up participants at the end of a program. The grace period begins at the time that the program is officially over. The late pick up fee is \$4 for every five minutes or part of five minutes after the grace period. Late pick up, if arranged with 24 hours notice, drops to \$2 for every five minutes or \$24/hour. If a parent is more than 20 minutes late, all efforts will be made to contact the parent including calling the emergency numbers provided on the health form.
