



## **Our Preventative Measures Regarding the COVID-19 Coronavirus**

The health and safety of the children and staff involved with Renaissance Adventures continue to be a top priority. We are closely monitoring the COVID-19 Coronavirus situation daily. We are taking precautions based on the guidelines of the CDC, the Colorado Department of Health, Boulder County Public Health, and the American Camping Association.

At this time, we have canceled all in-person programs throughout the rest of the school year. However, we have converted our normal live-action roleplaying programming into online tabletop gaming. Questers can log in to Zoom and video chat with friends, have a fun experience, and be the hero of a mythic quest... in the safety of their own home.

Once restrictions on in-person programming are lifted, we will analyze whether running summer camps is the appropriate action and continue to monitor the situation for the safety needs of our campers and staff. At this time, we are preparing to run both in-person programming and online programming during the normal summer break months, provided the COVID restrictions have been lifted.

When we open programming up for in-person camps again, here are the precautions we will potentially be taking for the entirety of the summer season, depending on the current situation with COVID-19:

- All Quest Leaders are trained in the Standard COVID-19 Health Protocols (see below).
- Programs will be held outdoors as much as the weather allows.
- All participants and staff wash their hands when they arrive at the site, and before and after eating snacks and lunch, and as needed. All sites have access to handwashing facilities.
- Camps will be limited in size and questing groups will average five or six participants.
- Each questing group stays separate from all other questing groups (no lunch games together, no dueling kids from other groups, etc.).
- We will coach participants in being aware of personal space and to stay 6' away from each other.
- Staff use gloves and disinfectant to routinely clean items that are handled frequently: doorknobs, bathroom handles, swasher handles, etc.

- When opening doors or turning sink handles - use a paper towel or gloves to avoid contaminating your hands. Nitrile exam gloves are available at all program sites and in each staff's first aid kit.
- Hand sanitizer is available at all programs. Rub the hand sanitizer over the entire hand until it is dry (for about 20 seconds). This is not as effective as handwashing, so wash hands frequently.
- Depending on the recommendations of health departments, we may test the temperature of all participants with a no-touch thermometer.
- If any child or staff shows signs of illness they will be sent home.
- We may choose to only use long swasher swords, to increase the distance between participants, or to only use thrown beanbag packets instead of swasher swords.

## **Standard COVID-19 Coronavirus Health Protocols (RA Follows All of These)**

- Stay home if you have any symptoms of illness.
- Stay home for 14 days if you have had close contact with someone who has COVID-19.
- Wash your hands frequently; lather and scrub for 20 seconds. Twenty seconds is about the length of time it takes to sing Happy Birthday twice. Handwashing protocol: wet, lather, scrub, rinse, dry.
- Avoid touching your eyes, mouth, nose, and face.
- Cover a cough with your elbow or a tissue.
- Stay 6' away from people.
- Avoid shaking hands (use a wave or elbow bump instead).

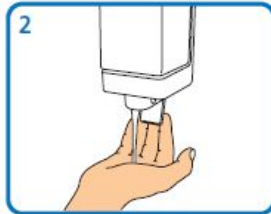

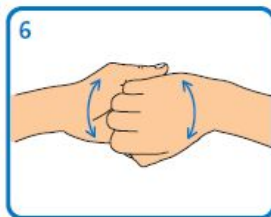

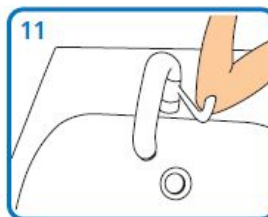
